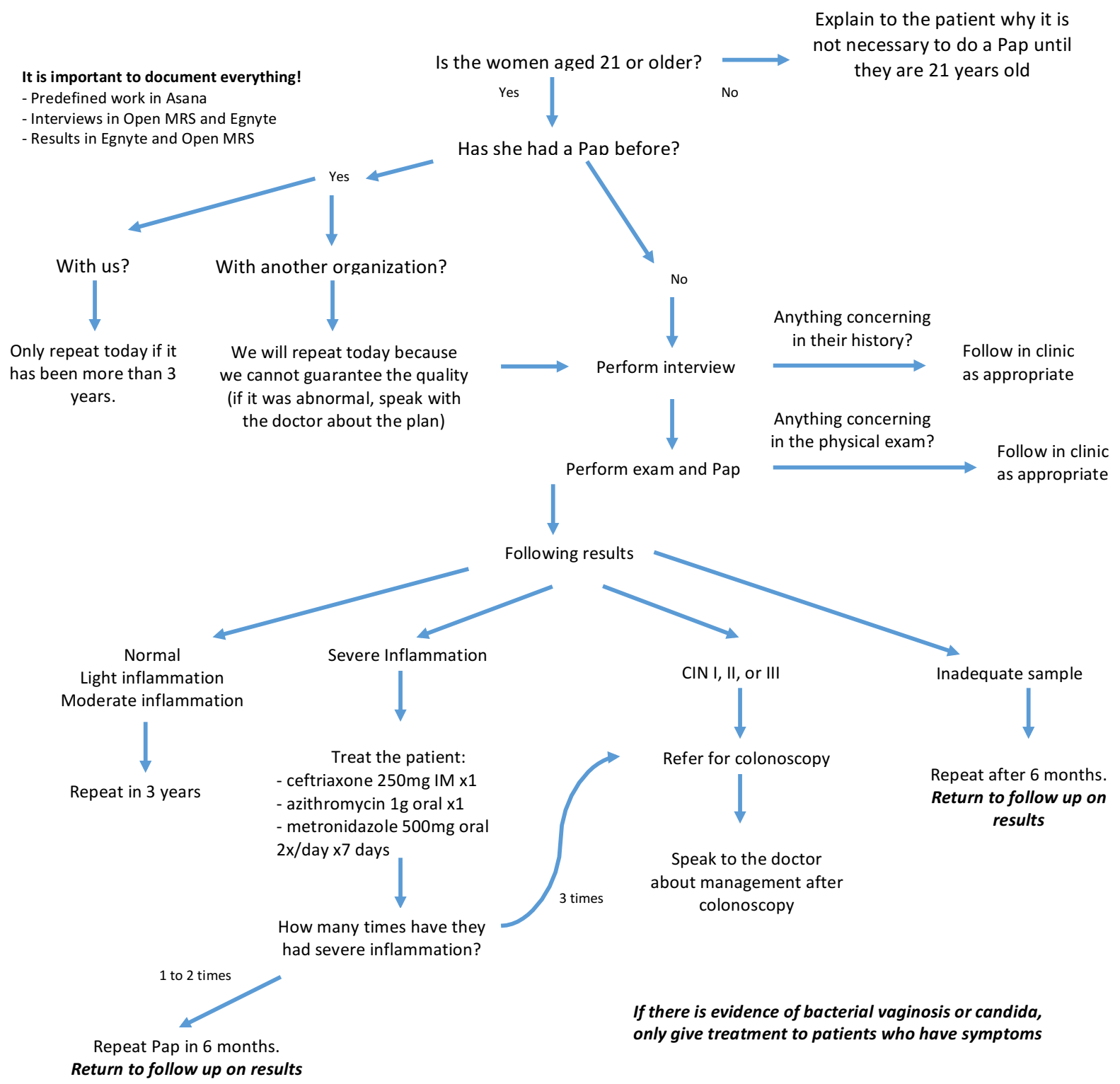


Pap Smear Protocol

It is important to document everything!

If there is evidence of bacterial vaginosis or candida, only give treatment to patients who have symptoms

Special cases

- 1) Women who have never had a partner: it is recommended to do a pap but it may hurt more; you may have to use a smaller speculum
- 2) Women who are older than 65 years
 - if they have never had a Pap before, they should have it done 2 times
 - if they have had a two normal Paps before they came in, they do not have to return
- 3) Women who have had hysterectomies: if the surgery was not for cancer, and if they removed cervix, they should have a Pap of the vagina after surgery
- 4) Pregnant women: it is safe to do a Pap during pregnancy, but if the patient prefers to wait, you may.
